- Provide data and information



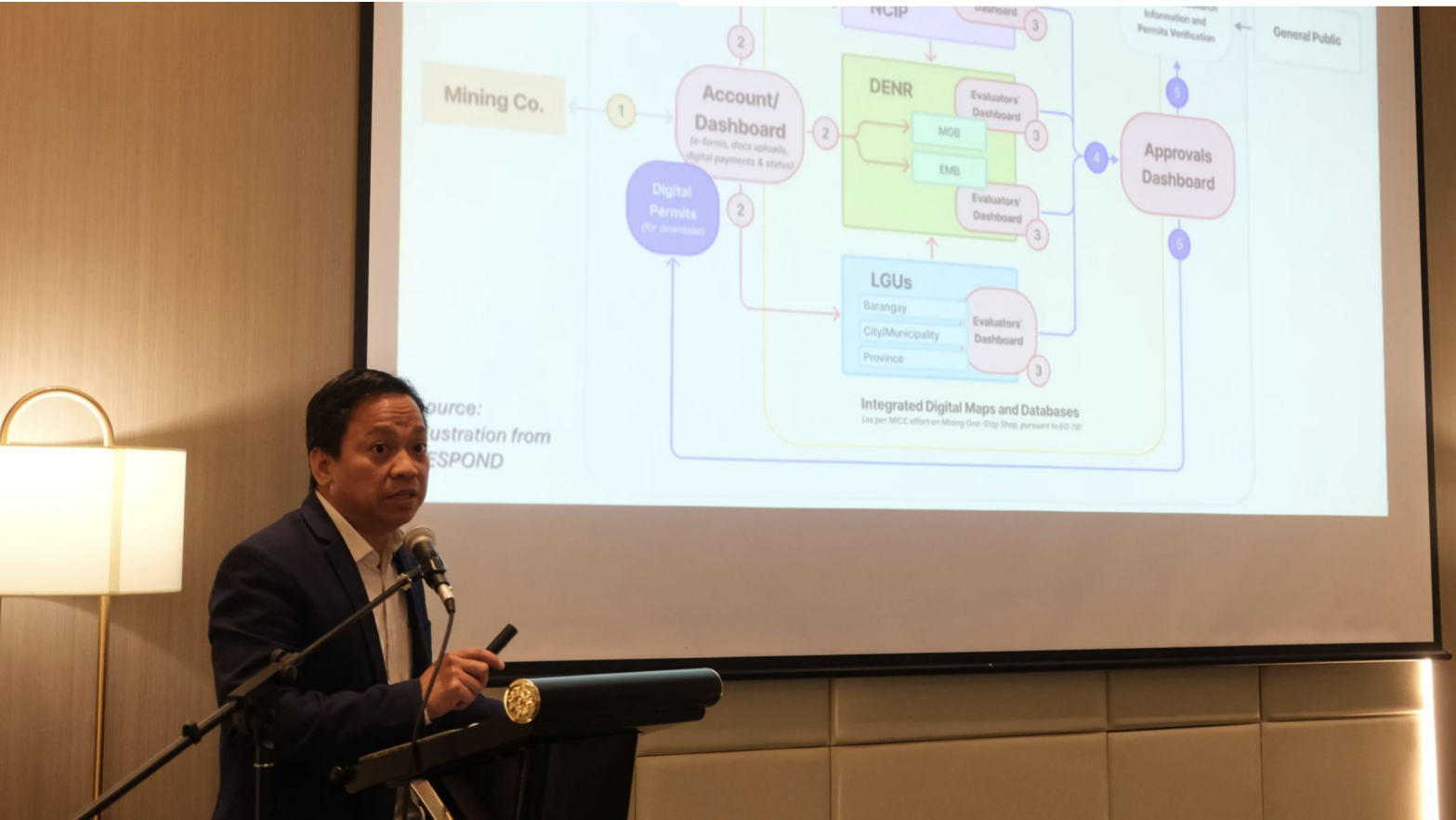

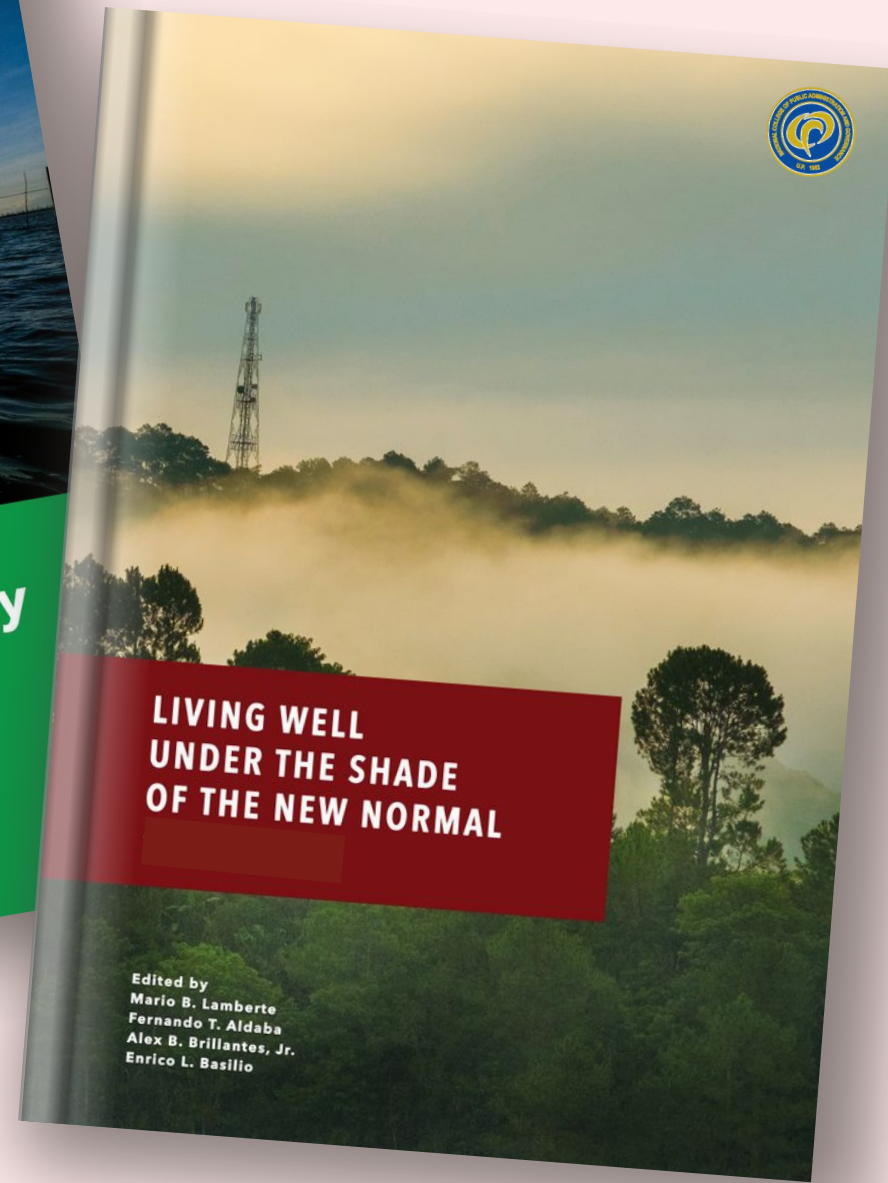
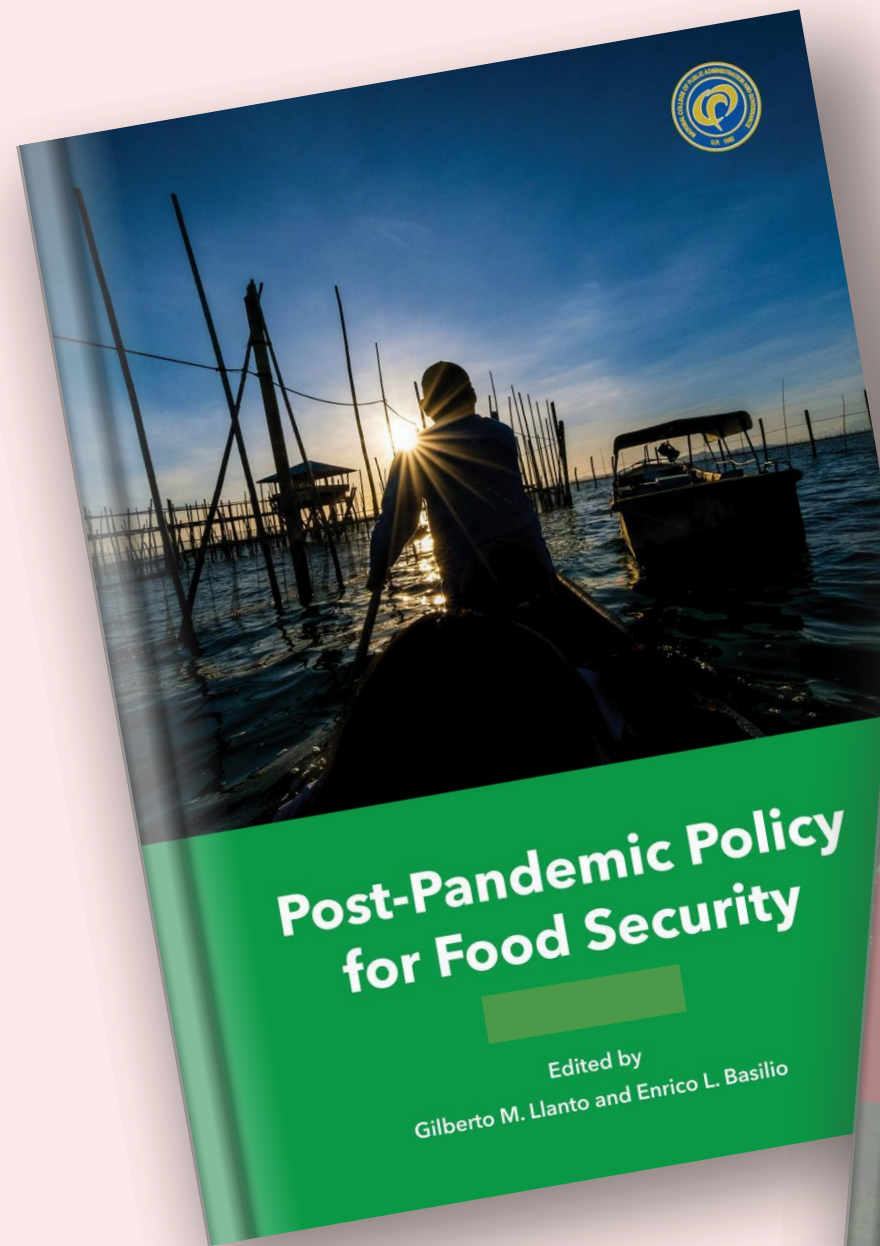
