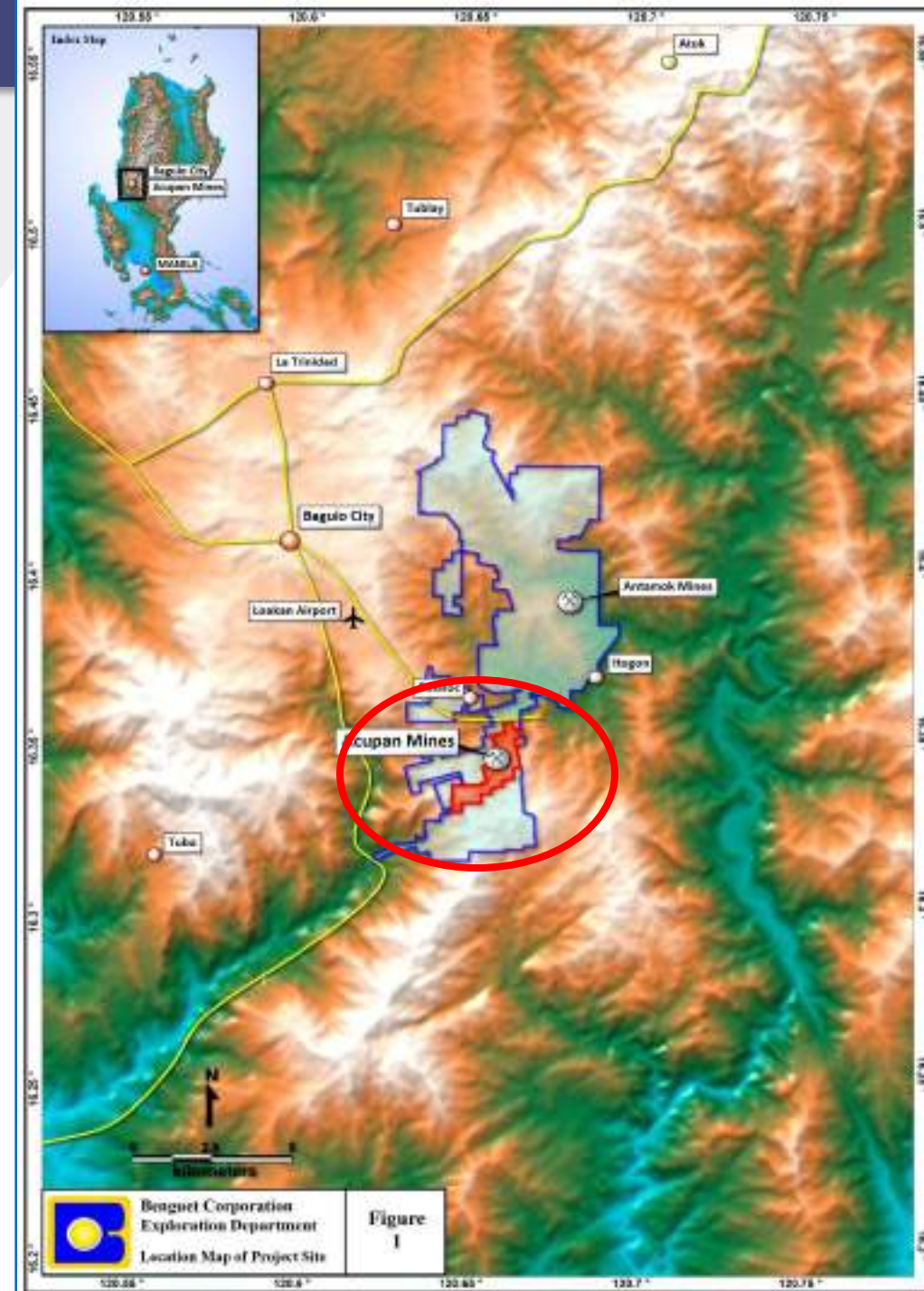

PROJECT LOCATION AND ACCESSIBILITY

- The mine is located about 9 aerial km southeast of Baguio City within the Municipality of Itogon, Benguet.
- It is presently accessible from Baguio City through 15 km of good, largely cement-sealed road.



BRIEF HISTORY OF THE BENGUET GOLD OPERATIONS

- Established in 1903**
- Since 1974 (end of Laurel-Langley Agreement), BC has been a Filipino-owned and managed mining company with a 121-year history in the Philippine mining industry**
- Pioneered modern mining in the country**
- BC's history is closely intertwined with economic life and progress of Baguio City**
- 1980s – biggest primary gold producer in the Philippines and 16th largest in the world**

CURRENT OPERATIONS

ACUPAN CONTRACT MINING PROJECT

- Conceptualized in 2002, it is a form of community based mining which involves the Government Regulatory Agencies, LGUs, the Small Scale Miners and the Company as Stakeholders.**
- After the devastation of the killer earthquake on 1990 aggravated by the low metal prices, the Company was constrained to suspend its operations and put under caretakership.**

- The Company as part of its CSR took a noble approach in addressing the issue by negotiating with the community leaders, the Indigenous Peoples and LGUs. leading to the birth of the ACMP operations.**
- This led to the birth of the ACMP where the Company entered into partnership with the Small Scale Miners who are members of the community and IPs, who then organized themselves into associations or cooperatives to do contract mining at the Acupan underground.**

- Au produced will be sold to BSP, revenues generated and taxes from the sales of gold will be shared 60% for Contractors and 40% for the Company.**
- Provide direct and indirect employment to more or less 3,000 local residents and IPs, regulates the Illegal SSM activities, provide safe, efficient and environment-friendly mining method, tax revenue generation for LGU, income generation for the stakeholders and other business opportunities to local residents and other service providers and suppliers nationwide.**

- **Benguet Corp is the first Mining Company in the Philippines to create and implement such partnerships establishing fruitful partnership and cooperation between a large scale mining company and the Small Scale Miners.**
- **The concept is the first of its kind and being promoted by the MGB to address and regulate illegal SSM activities in the country.**
