Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) plays a crucial role in supporting local government units (LGUs) in extractive industry monitoring and reporting.

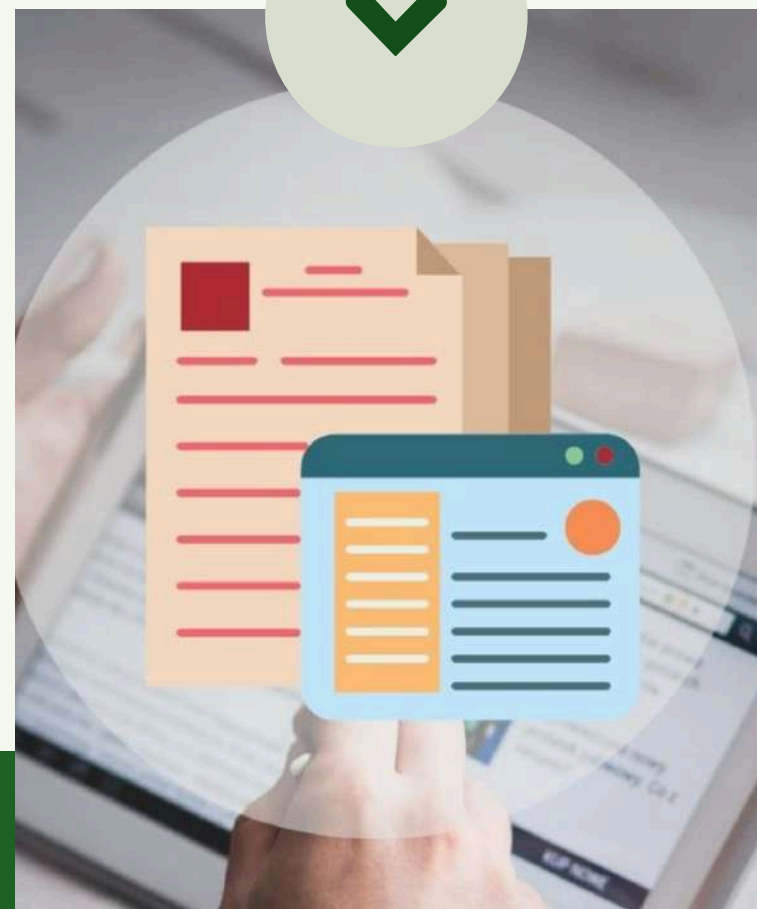

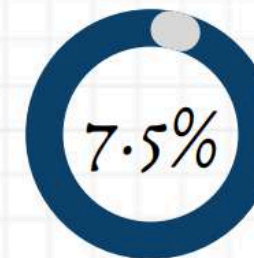

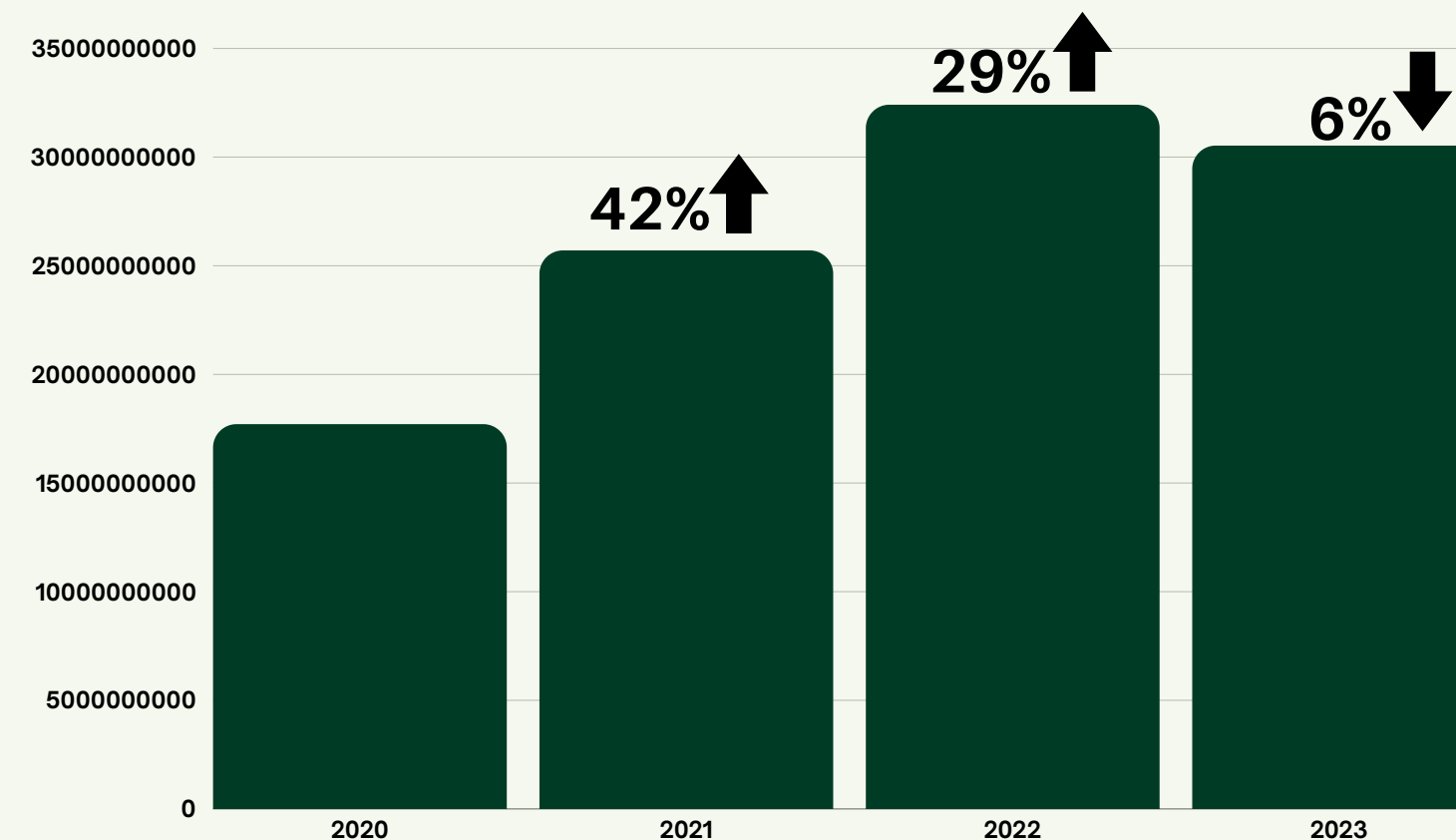
