

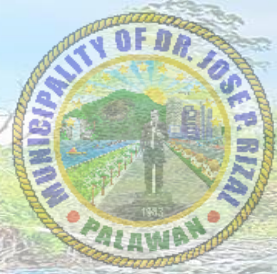

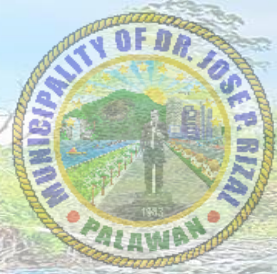
POINTS OF DISCUSSION

Discuss the long term-term financial implications of neglecting environmental compliance versus the short-term revenue gains from Mining and quarrying.



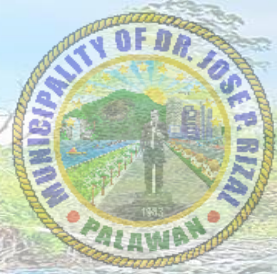
