

Agreements:

- 1. Agreed that the ToC framework should be appropriate to the PH-EITI context
- 2. Agreed that the ToC that will be crafted would identify interventions that can be implemented to address the gaps, policies that can be pursued or reformed, other necessary inputs and activities to be able to achieve the desired change or changes, and the monitoring and evaluation system
- 3. Agreed on the process of conducting the Theory of Change.

- 1. Reviewed the vision and mission of PH-EITI
- 2. Reviewed issues, recurring concerns from previous stakeholder engagement activities, and discussed in MSG meetings

- 4. Agreed on the core problem
- 5. Rooted the causes of the problems and the effects


