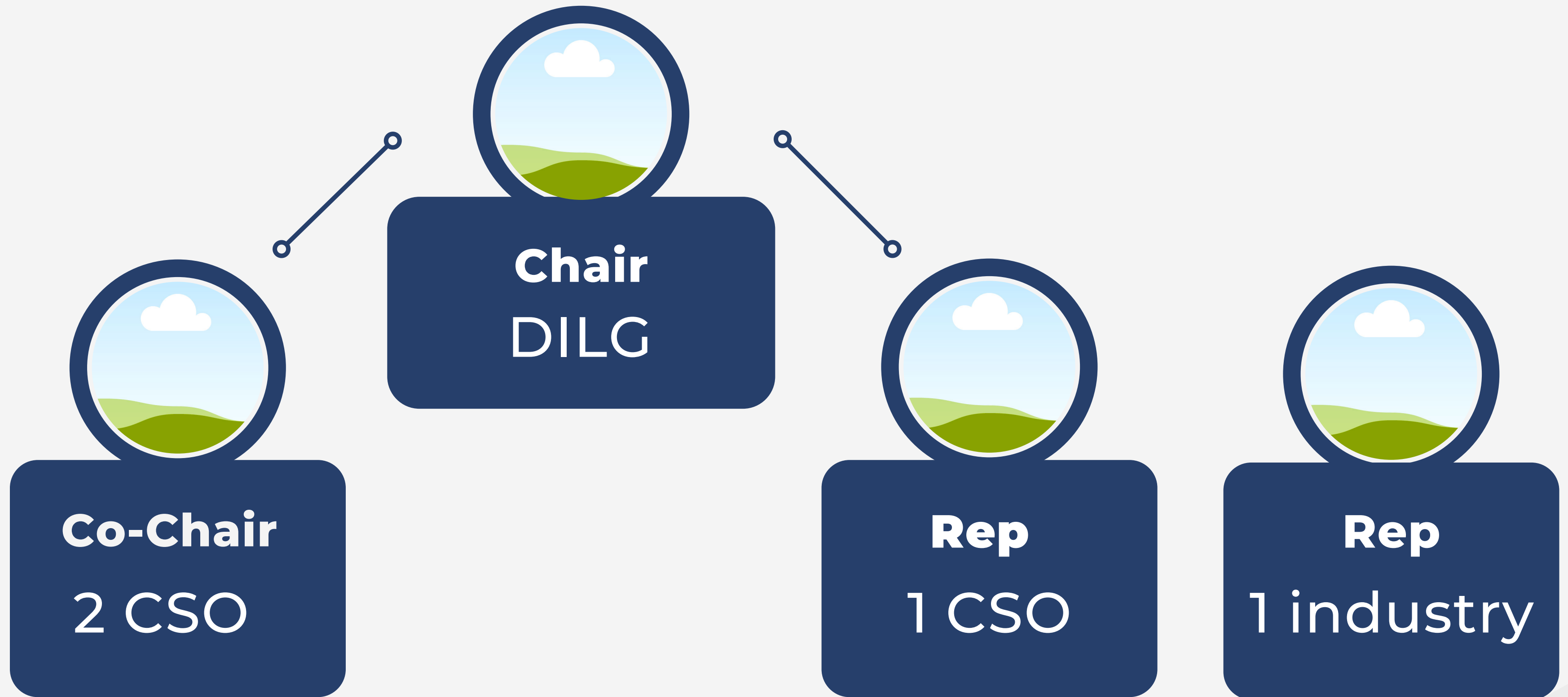
The MSG recommended and later decided on the formation of the Technical Working Group to initially work on the Theory of Change

Agreements:

1. Agreed that the ToC framework should be appropriate to the PH-EITI context
 2. Agreed that the ToC that will be crafted would identify interventions that can be implemented to address the gaps, policies that can be pursued or reformed, other necessary inputs and activities to be able to achieve the desired change or changes, and the monitoring and evaluation system
 3. Agreed on the process of conducting the Theory of Change.

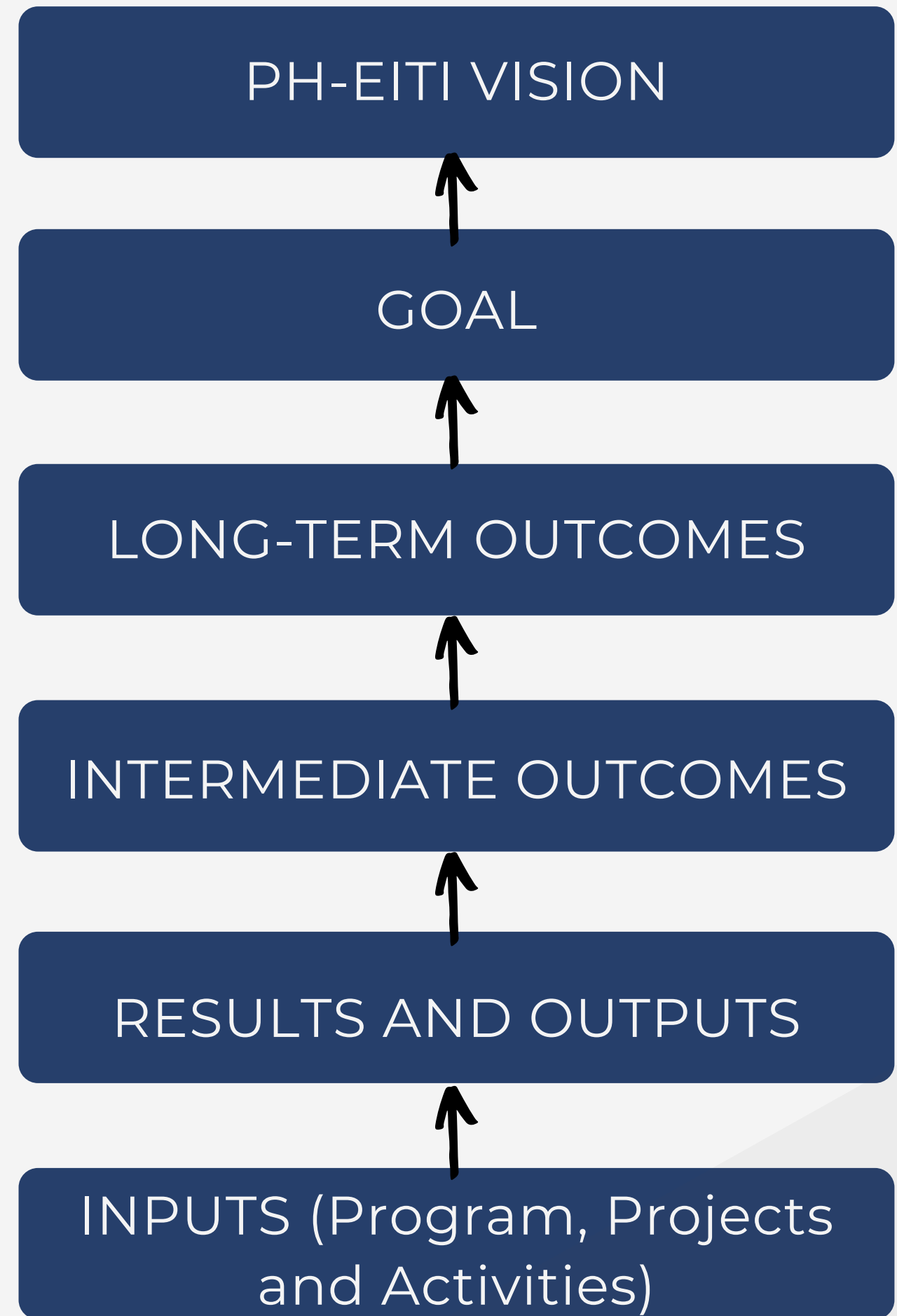
